Project Description:

Leander House, Inc. is a residential life-sharing organization for adults with developmental disabilities. It is made up of several life-sharing houses in the Southern Berkshire region of New England, which is 2 hours from both New York City and Boston. Some of the houses are located within walking distance to the downtown area of Great Barrington, Massachusetts. In addition to the houseparent(s), each house has a potential capacity of 3 residents and 1 or 2 volunteer co-workers.

Work: The volunteers have 6 weeks of vacation per year, during which time they are free to travel, if they choose. There are ample opportunities for the volunteers to socialize with the other volunteers from other local lifesharing homes. The volunteers primary responsibilities include transportation, direct care of the disabled adults and help in the household with cleaning, cooking, and grounds work. There is also the possibility of the volunteers offering something that they may wish to share (for example, a foreign language class, cooking class, sport club, etc.). Trainings while in service include First Aid, CPR, Human Rights, Applied Non-Violence, Fire Safety and a few others. More information can be found on our website at www.leanderhouse.org.

Requirements: : Willingness and ability to help and care for adults with disabilities; willingness to be around children; ability to work on a team; ability to be left alone and in charge of the household; willingness to join in; international or US driver's license, at least 6 months driving experience, no criminal history, at least 18 years of age and a graduate of high school. We are a smoking and alcohol-free facility.
