


# **CALL FOR GROUP LEADERS: "Gender in Motion"**

## **ABOUT THE PROJECT**

The youth exchange "Gender in Motion" aims to combat gender inequality and discrimination against the LGBTQI+ community through the use of social media.

A total of 40 participants from Italy, Spain, Portugal, Turkey and Latvia (8 participants/country) will develop skills to become active promoters of gender equality and LGBTQI+ rights by learning to use social media as tools for raising awareness, countering hate speech, and debunking fake news.

This exchange will offer a platform for young activists to develop ethical communication strategies and build social campaigns that promote equality and challenge biases related to gender and sexual orientation.

The project was initiated through a collaboration between SCI Italy and an organization in Diyarbakır. Both associations have developed expertise on gender-related issues through the implementation of Erasmus+ projects. The most recent one, "Digital Equality," was held in Rome in June 2025, and the partnership proved to be highly fruitful.

The idea now is to present a similar project, but with closer cooperation in order to strengthen the youth exchange by involving new partners — including those outside the SCI network — and to foster a richer exchange of ideas, particularly around gender equality, inclusivity, and social justice.

#### **Main Objectives**

A group of 40 young people from Italy, Spain, Turkey, Latvia and Portugal will participate in a collaborative program designed to reinforce international community bonds among young people who have faced discrimination due to their gender identity or sexual orientation with the aim of:

1. Training to Combat Gender Inequality: Equip participants with skills to recognize and



- challenge gender stereotypes in media and society.
- 2. Addressing LGBTQI+ Phobia in Social Media: Educate participants on identifying and responding to online disinformation and hate targeting the LGBTQI+ community.
- 3. **Awareness Campaigns:** Create multimedia content (videos, articles, photos) to promote inclusion and equality, engaging youth in combating fake news.
- 4. **Promoting Media Ethics:** Provide ethical guidelines for reporting on gender and LGBTQI+ issues to ensure respectful and inclusive communication.
- Developing Professional Skills: Offer practical tools to enhance participants' media competencies, such as writing, photography, video production, and social media campaign management.
- 6. **Promoting the Erasmus+ Program:** Highlight the importance of Erasmus+ as a tool to advance gender equality and LGBTQI+ rights.

## **TASK AS GROUP LEADER**

#### **BEFORE the Youth Exchange**

- Participate in an online meeting with the organizational team in September 2025.
- Participate and support the project coordinator in the Advanced Planning Visit (APV) in Diyarbakir from the 25th to the 28th of September 2025.
- Be responsible for collecting communication materials during the APV such as pictures, videos and small interviews about the experience, which are going to be posted and shared by the participating organizations in real time during the APV.
- Help with the logistics of your group 7 participants (organize trips, prepare meetings with the group, collect specific needs)

#### **DURING the Youth Exchange**

- Be responsible for your group (its well-being, motivation and team spirit) during the week of the Youth Exchange (8th - 16th October 2025).
- Support the implementation of the project and its activities
- Daily evaluation with the group

# **AFTER the Exchange**

- Support with the reporting
- Assist with the administration (collect tickets, photos, reports, assessments, etc.)



# **REQUIREMENTS**

The ideal group leader:

- Over 18 years old;
- has experience in working with young people, coordinating groups and non-formal education methods;
- has the interest, motivation, and willingness to follow the project from its beginning to its end;
- has a good knowledge of English and can translate for the participants if necessary;
- has a positive and proactive attitude;
- is very patient, tolerant, and open minded;
- has good organizational skills;
- can cooperate with the organizational team;
- feels responsible for the group, especially for the participants that come from disadvantaged backgrounds.

# **ECONOMIC CONDITIONS**

This project is granted by Erasmus+, meaning that all the essential costs of the activities are covered: accommodation, food, travel costs up to a maximum amount per country.
