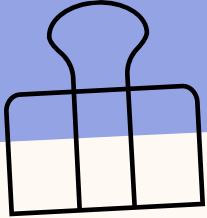


Our Philosophy

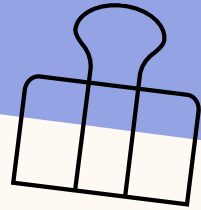

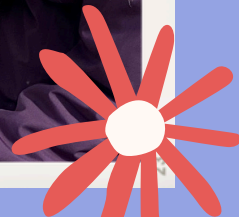
About us

Location



Our organization is based in the center of Miercurea Ciuc, a small town with a population of about 34,000 inhabitants. It lies in the Székely Land, a mainly Hungarian-speaking ethnocultural region in eastern Transylvania, and is situated in the Olt River valley. Miercurea Ciuc has a cool continental climate, without a dry season. Although activities take place in Romania, most of the locals are Hungarian speakers.



LOGISTICAL MATTERS



1. Accommodation

- Max. 2 volunteers in the same room, with gender-separated rooms
- Fully furnished accommodation
- A well-equipped kitchen
- Bathroom with toilets and showers
- Shared kitchen and bathroom with other volunteers living at the accommodation.
- Basic furniture items in the rooms of volunteers
- Internet connection in the accommodation

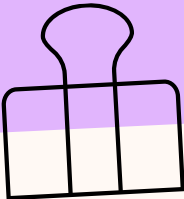
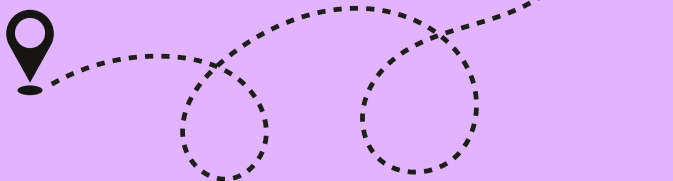

4.HEALTH INSURANCE

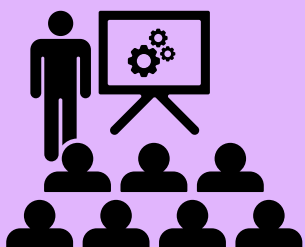

6.CERTIFICATES

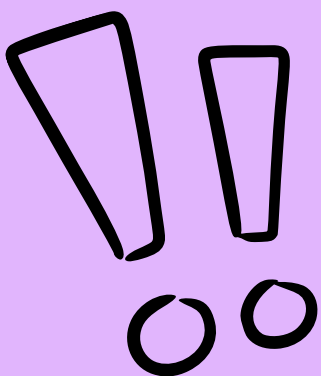

IMPORTANT!

- ALTHOUGH ACTIVITIES TAKE PLACE IN ROMANIA, THE MAJORITY OF THE LOCAL COMMUNITY HAS HUNGARIAN ETHNICITY, MEANING THAT MOST OF THE LOCALS ARE HUNGARIAN SPEAKERS.
- VOLUNTEERS CAN WORK TOGETHER WITH US AND CREATE MATERIALS IN OUR OFFICE, WHICH IS 20 MINUTES FROM THEIR ACCOMMODATION.
- VOLUNTEERS WILL WORK FLEXIBLY FOR 6-7 HOURS A DAY, 5 DAYS A WEEK.
- VOLUNTEERS WILL GET 2 DAYS OF HOLIDAY PER MONTH, ACCORDING TO ESC GUIDELINES.

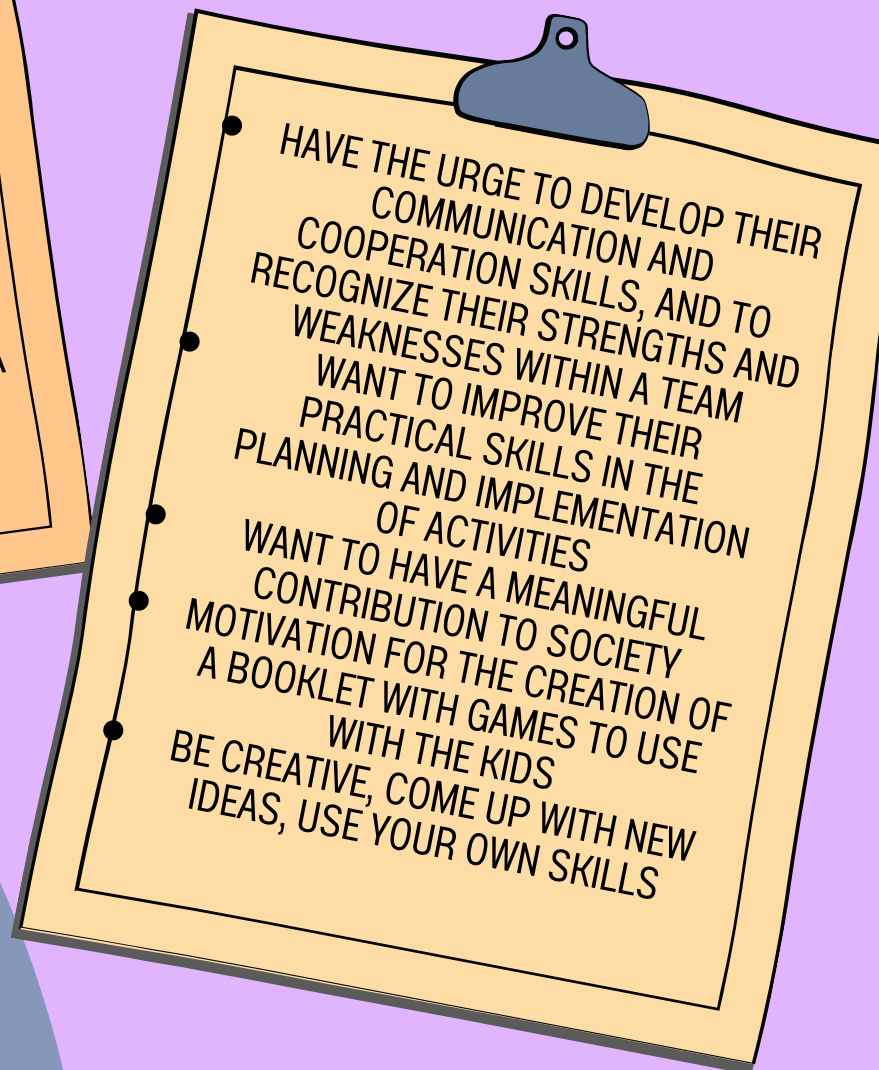

PARTICIPANT PROFILE



3 volunteers needed for 8,5 months

Activity description

Volunteering in Miercurea-Ciuc is all about making a real difference in the lives of children aged 7 to 18 living in five foster care homes. These kids come from tough backgrounds and need support with English, homework, life skills, and social development. Volunteers spend 1 to 3.5 hours daily running creative learning activities, playing games, and organizing fun outdoor adventures like picnics and sports.

Teamwork is key, with volunteers planning, brainstorming, and evaluating activities together. Mornings are for prep, language classes, and team meetings, while the real action happens in the afternoons. Volunteers also help with school pickups when needed and keep track of progress through reports and feedback. It's a rewarding experience full of learning, teamwork, and unforgettable moments!

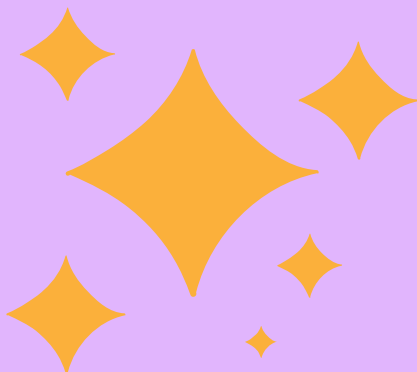

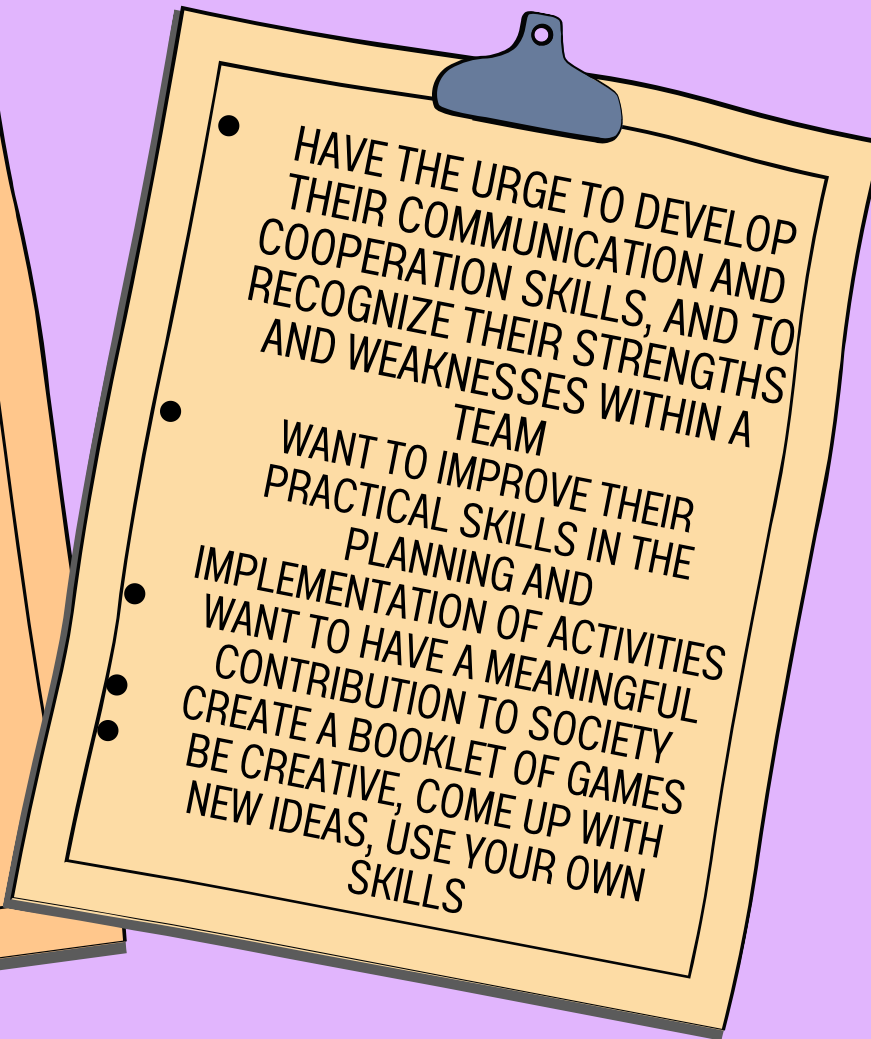
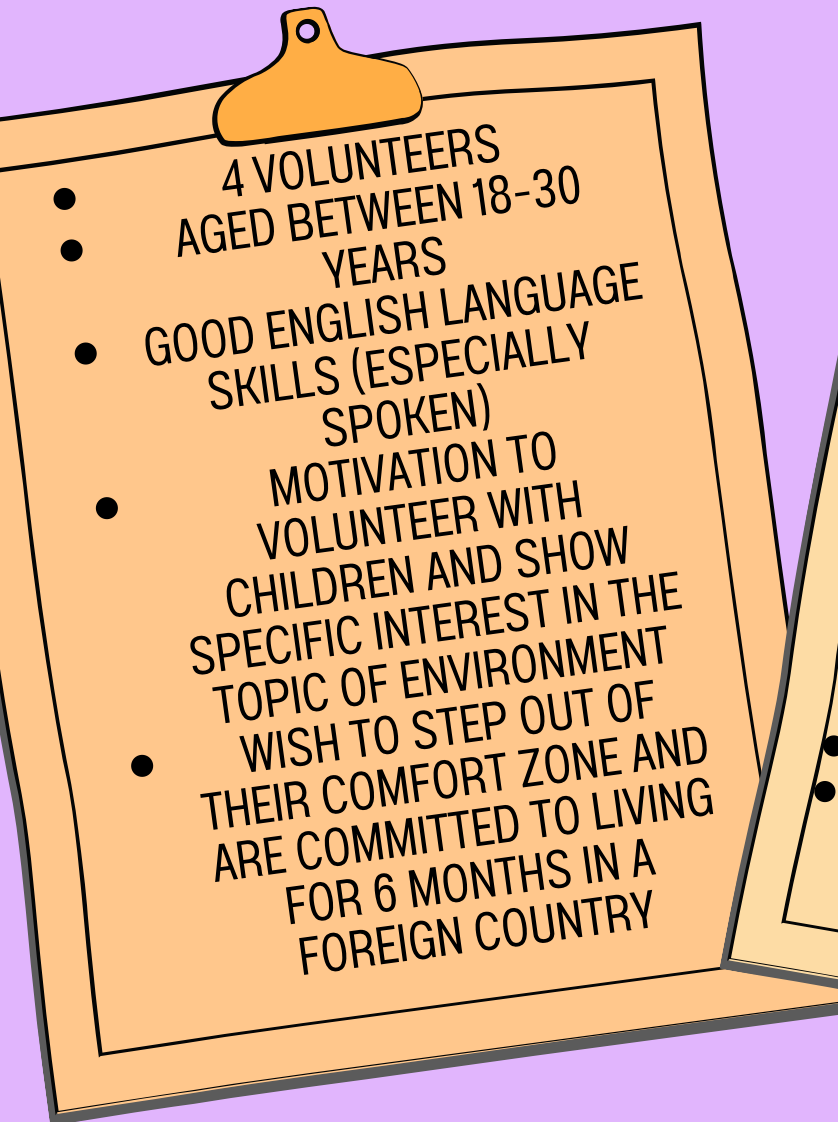

2. Teaching and Care in Afterschool Clubs 5.0

PARTICIPANT PROFILE



4 volunteers needed for 8,5 months

Activity description

In five After School Clubs in neighbouring villages, volunteers support children weekly by helping with homework, teaching English through games, and building essential life and social skills. These clubs provide a safe and enriching space where kids learn teamwork, responsibility, and emotional resilience. Activities last 1 to 4 hours and are tailored to each club's needs.

Volunteers also work on promoting green practices. They help maintain a Game Booklet to ensure future volunteers can continue their work seamlessly. Another exciting part of the role is inspiring local students to become volunteers by sharing experiences in schools, raising awareness, and promoting community involvement. It's an impactful and rewarding experience that makes a lasting difference!

Plan, organize, and facilitate different After School Club activities for disadvantaged children in the surrounding villages, with a focus on non-formal and informal learning activities outside of school;



Collect or even produce the tools used for non-formal activities with children;



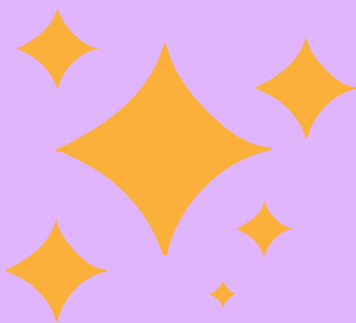

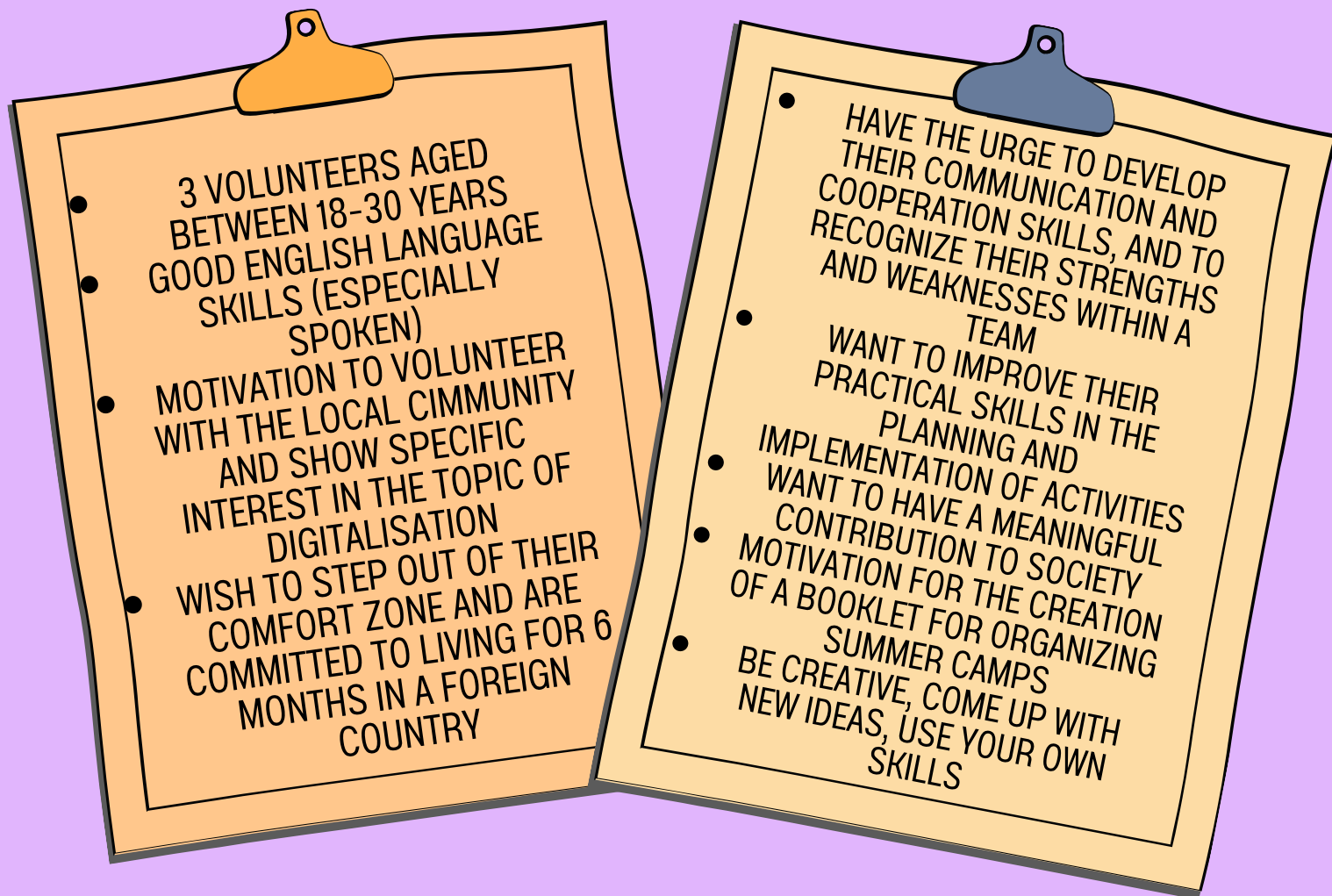

PARTICIPANT PROFILE



The main focus of this activity will be on the topic of the "Digitalisation"

2 volunteers needed for 9 months

Activity description

Volunteers will bring the community together by organizing exciting events like language clubs, quiz nights, and board game nights! In language clubs, locals get to practice foreign languages in a fun and interactive way, with volunteers leading discussions in their native tongues. Quiz nights happen once every month at a café, featuring 8 rounds of engaging questions, with local volunteers helping non-English speakers participate.

Volunteers will also introduce fun, non-formal activities on digital awareness. To ensure future volunteers can continue their work smoothly, they will create an extension to the "Community Clubs - Tools and Techniques" booklet, documenting event ideas and best practices. Lastly, volunteers will visit local schools to promote volunteering and the ESC Programme, inspiring others to get involved. It's all about connection, learning, and making a lasting impact!

MAIN TASKS OF THE VOLUNTEERS



Organising community-building activities involving the local community;



Organising language clubs, quiz nights, board game nights, activities on digital awareness in clubs and during activities with children, etc. for the local community;



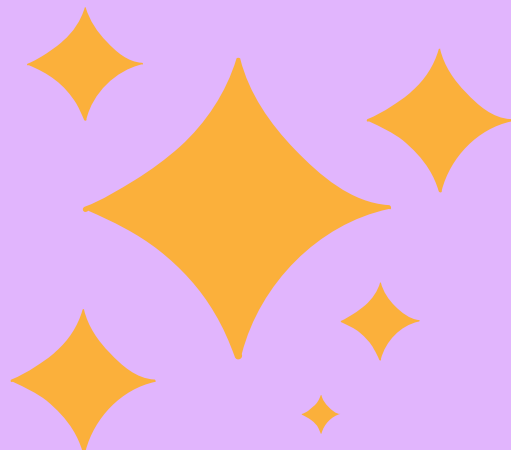
